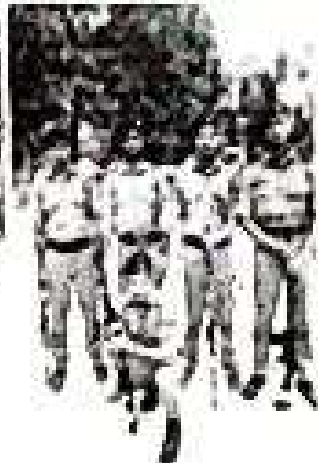
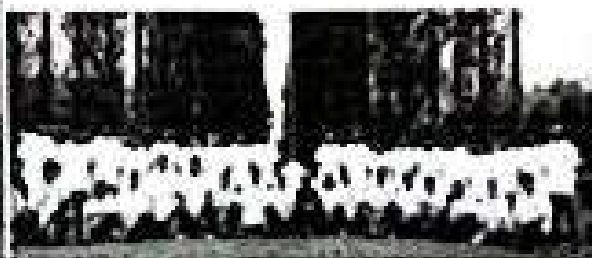

Campus Plantation Drive (21st March, 2018)

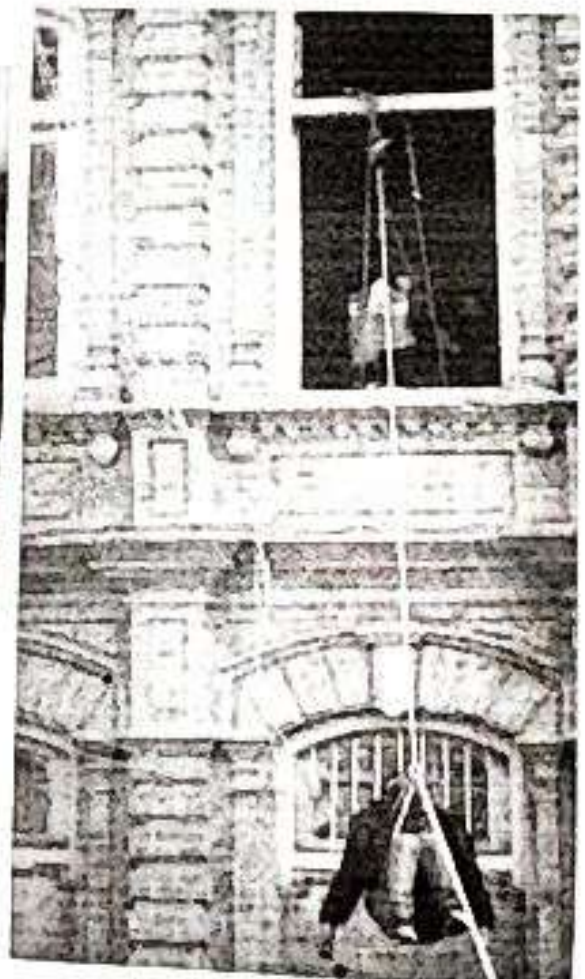
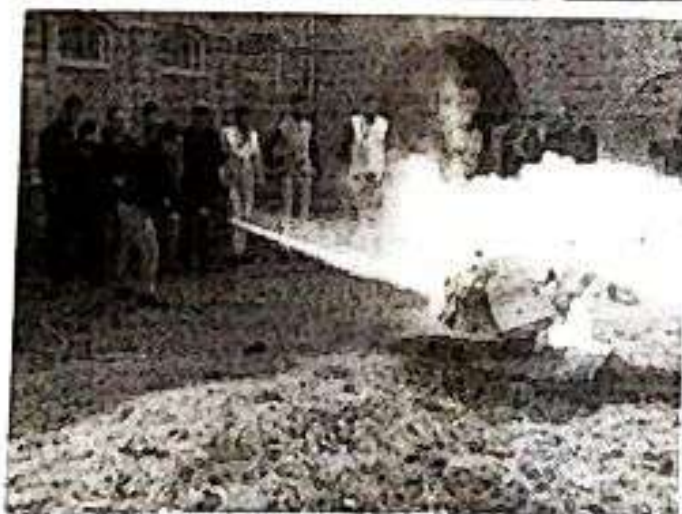

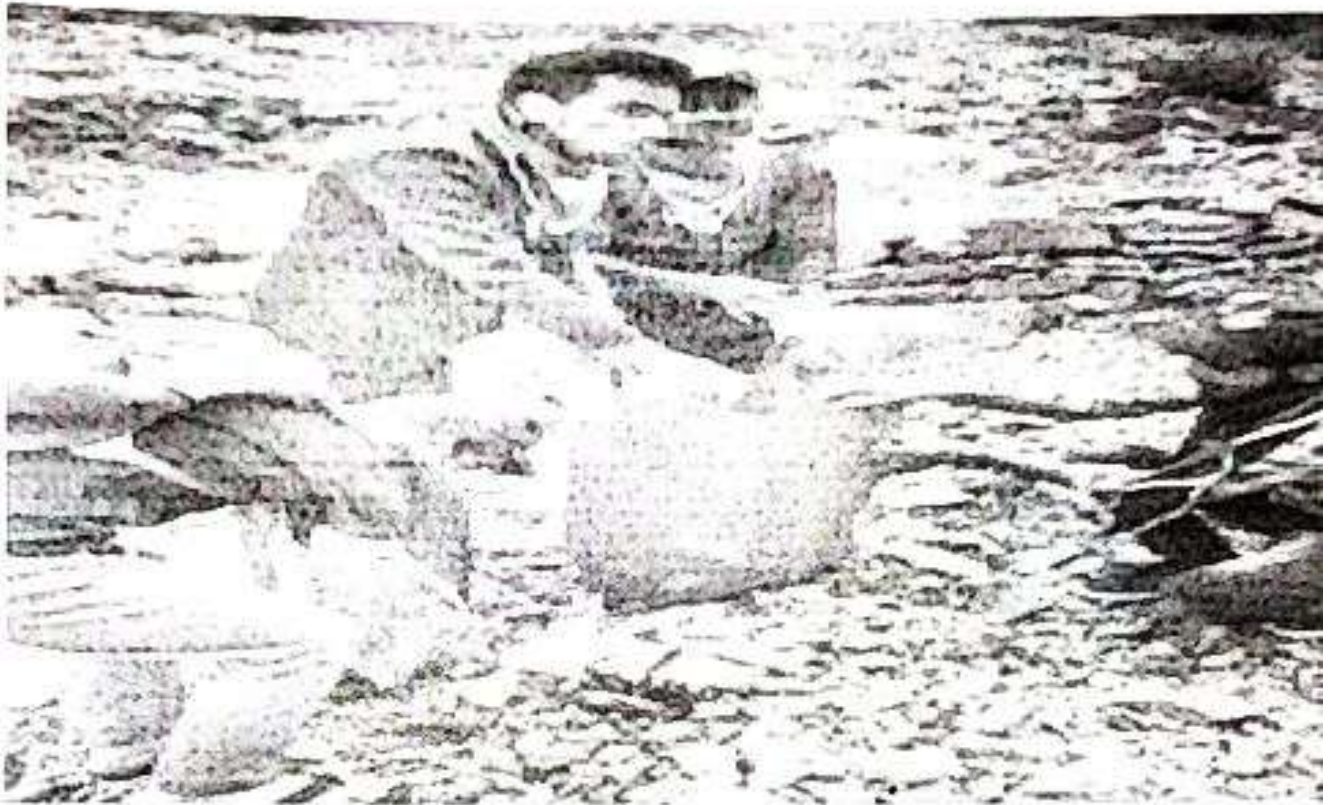
Traffic Awareness Programme

Report on Swachh Bharat Summer Internship(SBSI) 2.0 Programme (2019)

The Swachh Bharat Summer internship (SBSI) 2.0 comprising of 50 Hours of Swachhata is to encourage the young folk across the country, develop their skills and orientation for sanitation related work thereby making Swachh Bharat Mission a Janandolan. In pursuance to this vision of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, Amar Singh College launched the special cleanliness drive and formally constituted three nodal officers to monitor and coordinate cleanliness activities in the college with an objective to accelerate efforts to achieve sanitation coverage, improve cleanliness and eliminate open defecation. The broad plan of action was as follows:

1. Generating mass awareness on cleanliness and hygiene amongst students and staff members by holding regular 'Sensitization Programmes' on 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' so as to motivate them to contribute to this Campaign in a proactive manner.
2. Activities under 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' will be a key component of all the community work being done by NSS volunteers of the college.
3. Students and Teachers will regularly participate in the special cleanliness drive in the college campus on continuing basis.
4. Events such as poster competitions, Quizzes, debates, painting competitions, essay writing, poetry writing/ reciting, speeches, skits on 'Swachh Bharat' will be organized.
5. Rallies on themes connected with 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' in and around the college campus will be conducted to create mass awareness on such issues.
6. Eminent people will be invited to address students and staff members on issues connected with 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan'.

7. Removal of all kind of waste material like plastic wastes, polythene wastes ,unusable non bio-degradable material etc and weeding out the old flood damaged books not in use from the library.

8. Administration of the Mass pledge by students and staff members to maintain cleanliness of the college campus and its surrounding areas on regular basis.

9. Conduct of workshop on the reuse and recycle of the waste material.

10. Constitution of the student sub-committees to conduct the regular inspection of the canteen,toilets, hostel, corridors and surrounding of college building.

11. Cleanness drive at adopted Villages as a part of social responsibility in the form of Special Summer Camp

Cleanliness Drive under Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan

Since cleanliness satisfies half of our Emaan, keeping this into consideration, NSS units of Amar Singh College along with NSS Volunteers, carried out the massive cleanliness drive and awareness campaign under theme 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan' as part of "Punctuality Week". The principal of the college along with other staff (teaching, non-teaching, sweepers, gardeners) participated whole heartedly in this Abhiyan. Moving on with the Swachh Abhiyan towards realizing the mission of clean India the entire college campus was cleaned properly especially the canteen area, on 2nd April, 2019. The Principal kick started the programme with the enriching bytes wherein she laid stress on the fact that cleanliness drive should continue till the people inculcate the habit of keeping their surrounding clean. Everyone worked with determination thereby putting their best effort to maintain cleanliness of the entire college campus. The committee on Swachh Bharat Abhiyan organized massive cleanliness drive in the college premises. Principal Madam, Prof (Dr.) Shaheen Altaf, faculty members and students voluntarily participated by cleaning the playgrounds, classrooms and corridors of the college. The students and staff members took voluntary oath to maintain cleanliness of the college campus and its surrounding areas on regular basis.

Periodic cleanliness and anti Polythene drives shall be conducted in the college premises as a preventive measure to control the plastic pollution in the college.

The awareness online/recorded lectures, movies and workshop were displayed on "Issues in Environmental Hygiene & Health" on 3rd July, 2019 in the college. A panel of experts among the faculty members were also invited to create awareness about cleanliness, hygiene, sanitation and the various diseases that are caused due to poor hygienic conditions. Discussions were held that emphasized upon the importance of cleanliness and sanitation as well as its implementation in the daily lives. Nodal officers designated by the college trained some students who in turn stressed upon the other classmates to follow certain good practices like keeping the surroundings clean, avoiding littering in public places, refraining from using plastic bags and spitting on the road etc. videos/ short clips were shown in smart classroom of which were based on "Waste Management and Environmental Health". The activities included the discussions on reversal of lost biodiversity through conservation of natural ecosystems and ecological restoration of degraded lands. 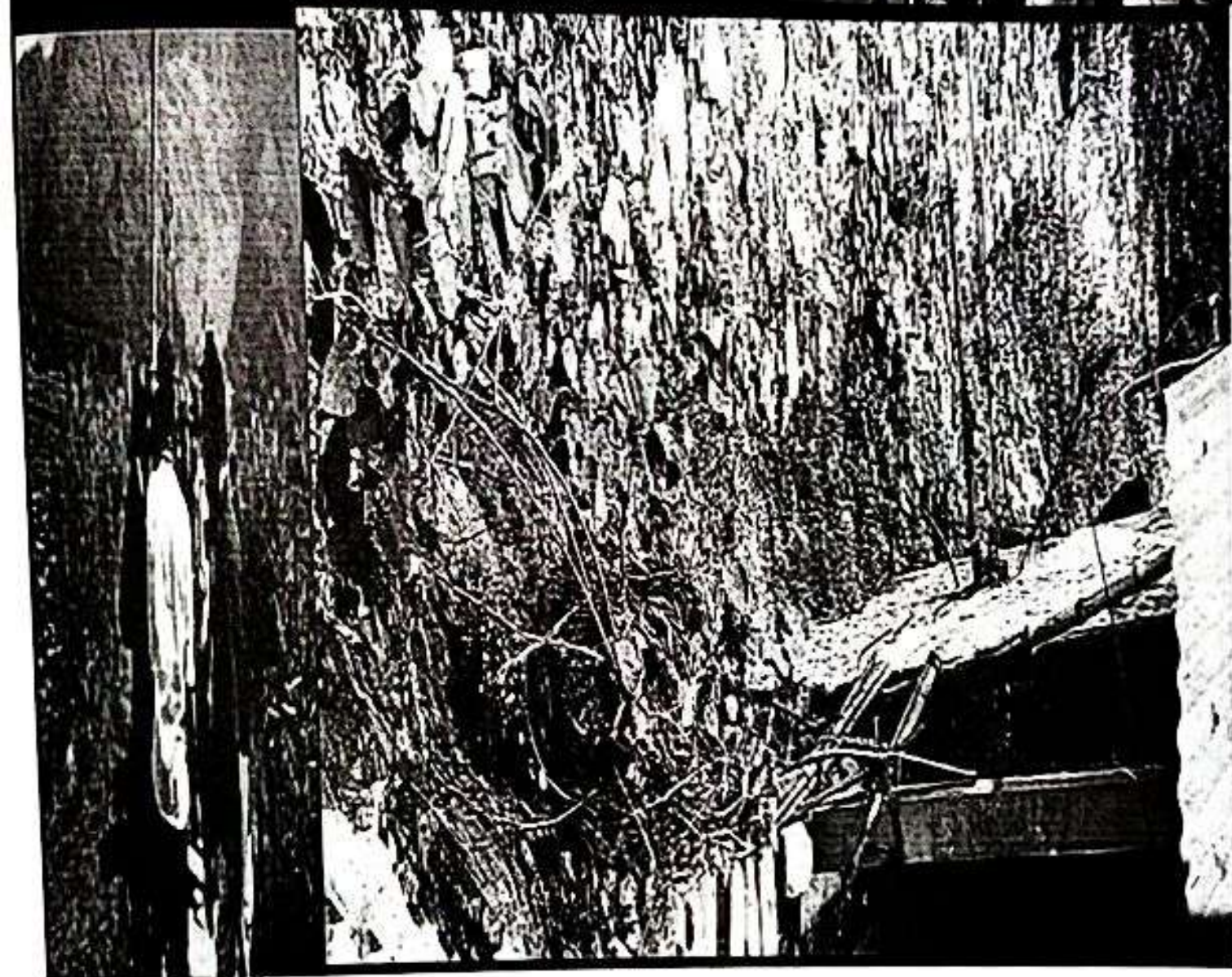

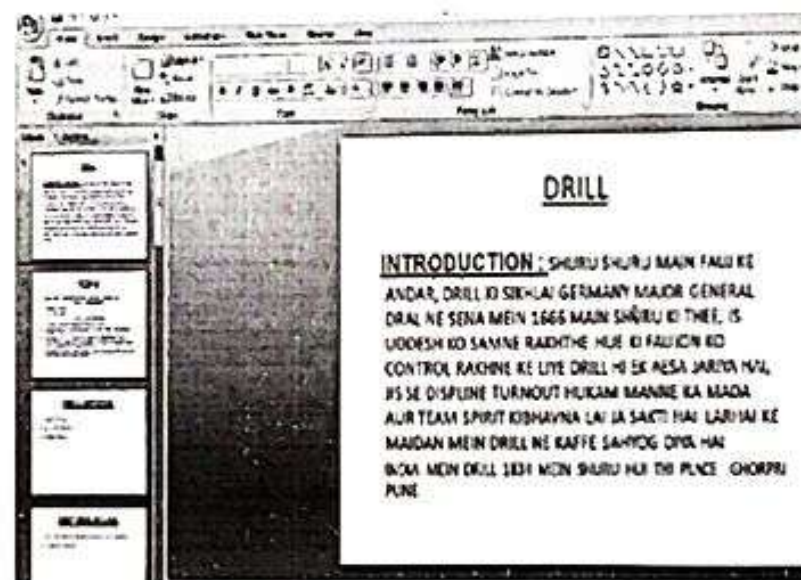

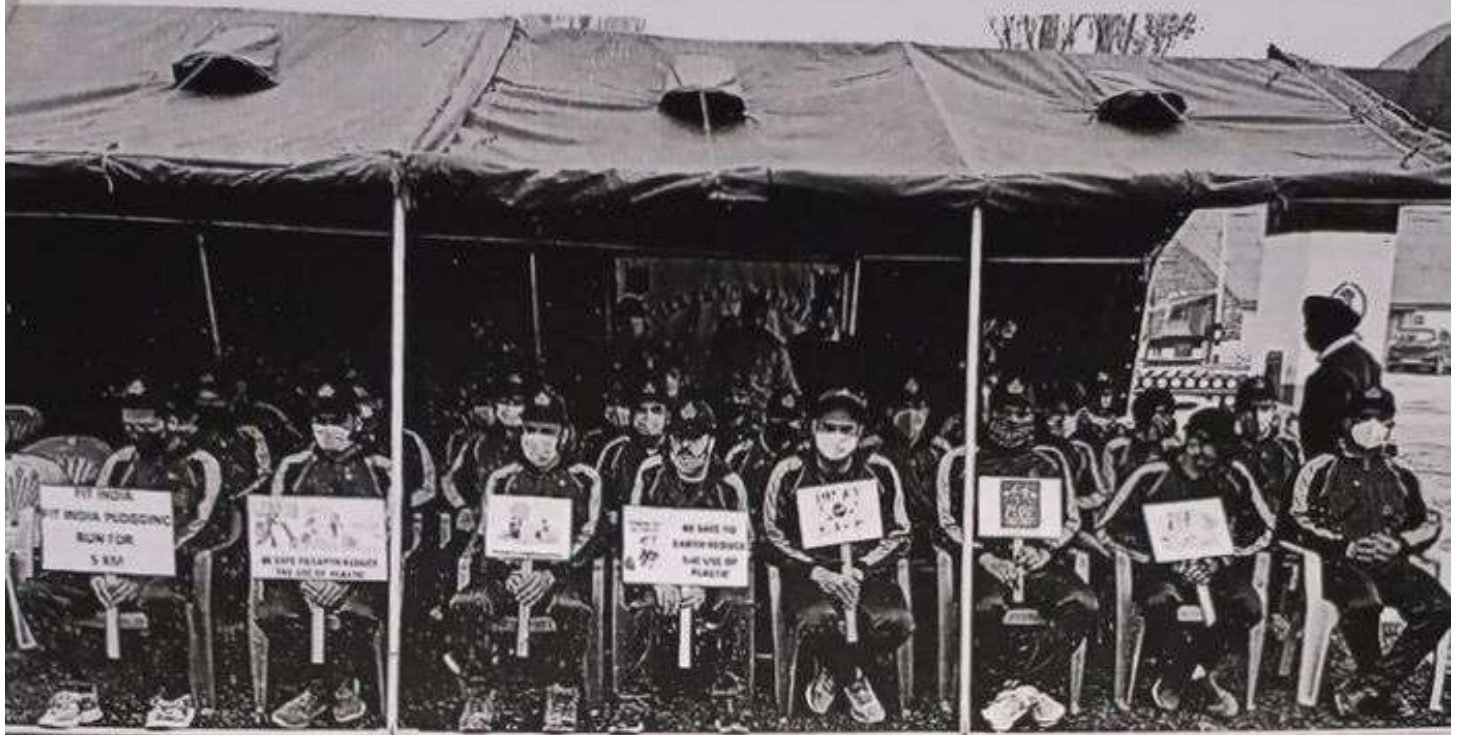

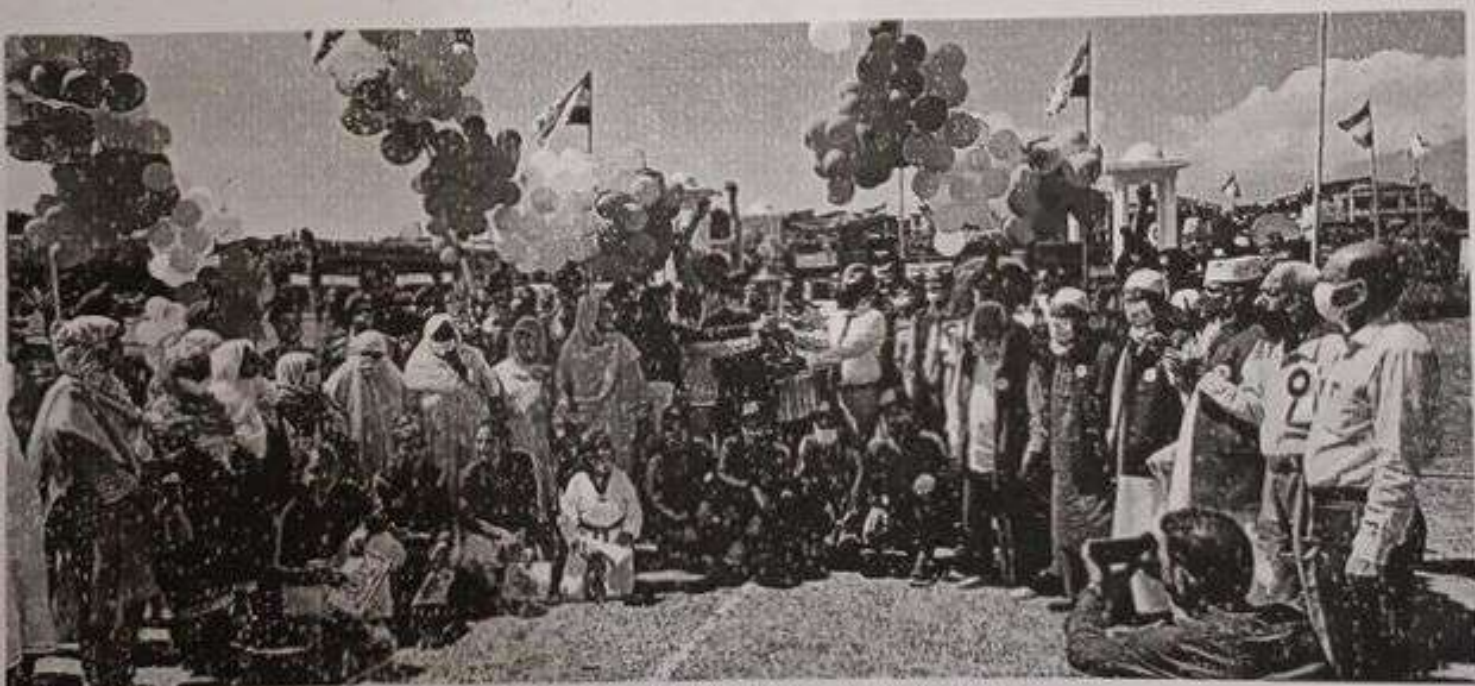

KARGIL VIJAY DIWAS

It was on July 26, 21 years ago that the Indian Army recaptured the Indian parts in Kargil that had been occupied by Pakistanis. Since then, July 26 has been observed annually to commemorate the sacrifice made by soldiers in this war.

The war took place between May and July 1999 in Jammu and Kashmir's Kargil district. The conflict is believed to have been orchestrated by the Pakistan Army Chief General Pervez Musharraf without the knowledge of then Pakistan Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif.

It began with the infiltration of both Pakistani troops and terrorists into Indian territory. The infiltrators positioned themselves in key locations that gave them a strategic advantage during the conflict. Based on the information from the local shepherd, the Indian Army was able to ascertain the points of ingress and launch "Operation Vijay".

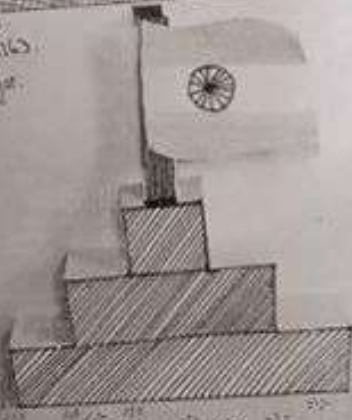
The Army declared the mission successful on July 26, 1999. Since then, the day has been celebrated annually as Kargil Vijay Diwas.

The victory came at a high price. The official death toll on the Indian side was 527, while that on the Pakistan side was between 357 and 453.

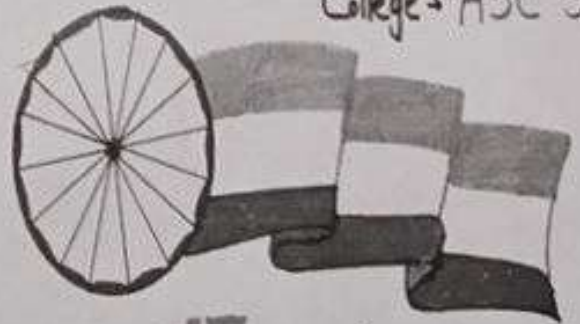
