LOCF SEMINAR ON TRAUMA LIT

OF THE ONE-DAY LOCF SEMINAR ON TRAUMA LITERATURE AND ITS RELEVANCE IN CURRICULUM

Department of English organised One-day LOCF Seminar on "Trauma Literature and its Relevance in Curriculum". The Inaugural function started at 10:00 AM and was formally inaugurated with a rendering of a song by the students of our college. The song was organized by the Department of Music under the tutelage of Head of Music Department, Prof Mudasir Anjum. . The host for the event, Professor Bashir Ahmad Rather, Principal Amar Singh College delivered the welcome address. He threw light on the LOCF. He laid thrust on a new type of pedagogy that is student centric. He also added that the curriculum should develop skills and general employability for our youth.





Keynote address was delivered by Dr Mufti Mudasir. He gave out a brief outline of Trauma Studies highlighting the inextricable link between Trauma and memory—the politics of remembering and forgetting. Trauma as an unspeakable and un-representable psychological response of an individual poses a challenge as far as its representation in Literature is concerned. He laid stress on the ethical value of Trauma Studies as an effective tool in highlighting the repressed and oppressed histories and its commitment towards social awareness and change. On this occasion Dr Nasreen Malik, Dean Humanities and Liberal Arts laid stress on Trauma Literature and its relevance in curriculum. She reiterated the fact that resistance and growth are possible in the aftermath of Trauma.

Professor MY Peerzada, (dean Academic Affairs) Chief Guest for the event stressed on the relevance of learning outcome based framework of Curriculum. Such a vision of Curriculum will enhance the skills of our students and transform them from being mere consumers of knowledge to producers of knowledge. The first technical session started at 11:30 AM at Taseer Hall with Dr Nasreen Malik as the chairperson. Dr. Junaid Shabir, Assistant Professor, Department of English acted as the panelist. The workshop comprised of two technical

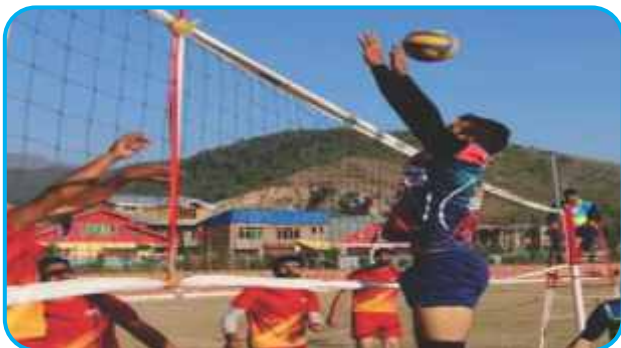
