Learning Objectives:

- The courses taught in the college in first two semesters are designed to build a foundational understanding of Persian language by acquainting the students with Persianate culture and basic Persian Language and Literature.
- The initial courses largely focus on enhancing the language skills of students in spoken as well as written Persian.
- In continuation with the above mentioned objectives the course also focuses on developing linguistic accuracy and improve reading, comprehension and basic writing skills of the students. The students are encouraged to participate in the various classwork activities like oral expression, class projects, role plays, interviews etc.
- In the succeeding courses i.e third and fourth semesters the focus shifts on various aspects of literature like forms of poetry, and understanding of prose and literary history.
- In the last two semesters students are exposed to the Classical Persian prose, poetry and texts related to Indo-Persian history.
- Students are also exposed to the basic concepts of translation and simultaneous interpretation.

Course Outcome:

1. On graduation the students are expected to demonstrate the skills necessary for translation, and simultaneous interpretation from Persian to English and vice versa in addition to having a fair understanding of Persian Language and Literature.
